Topic 1: Problems that may be encountered when teaching primary maths in English rather than Chinese

Teaching mathematics in English may encounter problems that won't exist when the subject is taught in Chinese. Take **5 times 4** as an example. It could mean 5×4 , or **4 fives**. However, it could also mean **5 times** as big as **4**, and, in this case, should mean **5 fours**. While in Chinese, we have separate terms (' **5 乘以 4**',' **4 的 5 倍**') for the 2 cases, in English, we need to deal with the multiple meanings of **times**. This presentation will bring participants' attention to some of such problems.
